

Please read this Licence Agreement carefully as you will be bound by its terms if you use PRECIS.

The PRECIS modelling system (“PRECIS”) is a regional climate modelling system that can be run on a PC and applied easily to any area of the globe to generate high-resolution climate change predictions. PRECIS is supplied on two DVD-ROMs and comprises: executables and source of the Regional Climate Model (RCM) and control code; a set of sample lateral boundary conditions for driving the RCM; installation software; software for setting up, controlling and monitoring the RCM; software for managing output data; documentation.

PRECIS was developed by the Hadley Centre, part of the Met Office, with funding from the Department of the Environment, Food, and Rural Affairs (Defra) and the Department for International Development (DFID).

PRECIS Licence Agreement

1. Licence. The Met Office (“the Licensor”) grants you (“the Licensee”) a non-exclusive, non-transferable Licence to use the PRECIS software (“the Software”) accompanying this Licence.
2. General Restrictions. The software includes copyrighted material, trade secrets and other proprietary materials that are protected by copyright and other laws and international treaty provisions. You may not let, lease, sublicense, distribute, copy, reproduce, assign, share, sell, electronically transfer the software over a network to another computer or otherwise transfer your right to use it without the express permission of the Met Office.
3. Purpose. The Software is provided to you solely for bona fide research and must not be used commercially. THE USE OF PRECIS WITHIN PROJECTS RECEIVING FUNDING FROM INDUSTRY, COMMERCE, GOVERNMENT, EU OR ANY OTHER BODY REQUIRES THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE MET OFFICE.
4. Ownership. The ownership of and title to the software and any supporting documentation shall remain at all times with the British Crown, the Met Office or its licensor. The software and documentation are provided to you to allow you to exercise your rights under this Licence, which is granted to you.
5. Duration. This licence will remain in effect until terminated.
6. Termination. You may terminate this licence at any time by returning the software and related documentation to the Met Office. This Licence will terminate, immediately without notice from us if you fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Licence, or if you are given notice that the licence has terminated. Upon termination you must return the software and any related documentation.
7. Disclaimer of Warranty.
 - a. THE MET OFFICE DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES, REPRESENTATIONS AND PROMISES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF SATISFACTORY QUALITY AND FIT FOR THE PURPOSE. NEITHER DOES THE MET OFFICE MAKE ANY REPRESENTATIONS AS TO COMPATIBILITY WITH YOUR OPERATING SYSTEMS AND PLATFORMS.
 - b. In no event does the Met Office warrant that the software or related documentation will satisfy your requirements, that the software and documentation will be without errors or defects or that the operation of the software will be uninterrupted.
 - c. The Met Office have made PRECIS available on the basis that it is one of a number of tools for the development of climate change scenarios.
 - d. IN NO EVENT WILL THE MET OFFICE BE LIABLE FOR ANY OTHER DAMAGES, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF PROFITS DATA OR USE OF THE SOFTWARE OR FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL OR

CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, EVEN IF THE MET OFFICE HAS BEEN SPECIFICALLY ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

8. Upgrades. The Met Office reserves the right from time to time to make changes and upgrades to the software which on request will be provided to you under the same terms set out herein.
9. Licensee Obligations.
The Licensee will inform the Licensors of all purposes for which PRECIS is run and all uses to which PRECIS output data is put.
The Licensee will inform the Licensors of any publication or report arising from the use of PRECIS and in any such report or publication acknowledge the Licensors.
The Licensee will consent to the use of their name, address, e-mail address and information regarding their use of PRECIS in any website or publication associated with PRECIS.
The Licensee may not alter or modify the whole or any part of PRECIS.
The Licensee is aware of the limitations and uncertainties of PRECIS explained at the training course and in the accompanying workbook and will make this information available to users of data generated by PRECIS.
10. Entire Agreement. This License constitutes the entire agreement between us with respect to your rights or warranties for using the software and related documentation. If any provision of this agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable the remaining provisions shall continue in full force.
11. Governing Law. This Agreement is governed by and construed in accordance with English law, and shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts of England and Wales.
